On November 7, 2009 we will honor all who have fought for our freedom at the Veterans Day Parade and Day of Honor. Listed here is the street closings which include no parking areas. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause you. We hope you will be able to attend the parade and help us show support for the veterans who have gone before, and the men and women who find themselves in harms way today.

STREET CLOSINGS

The staging area will close at 8:00 AM, streets include:

- W. Kilbourn Ave. from N. 4th St. to N. 6th St.
- N. 4th St. from W. Wells St. to W. State St.
- 3rd St. from W. Kilbourn Ave. to W. State St.

The parade steps off at 1100 and will proceed east in the westbound lanes of W. Kilbourn Ave. to Plankinton Ave., south on Plankinton Ave. to E. Wells St., and east on Wells St. to Prospect Ave., south on Prospect to the Mason Street Bridge, east over the Mason Street Bridge, past the War Memorial to Veterans Park. The parade will last approximately 2 hours.

All cross streets to the parade route will close approximately 20 minutes prior to the start of the parade. The meters will be hooded and "No Parking" signs will be posted the night prior to the parade.
